The objectives of the program are (1) to engage participants in activities that embody principles of civic activism, and (2) to foster personal interaction with individuals who illustrate these principles in practice. The program will train participants in leadership skills through interactive group and peer-to-peer activities that emphasize team building, community activism, mentoring and civics. The four-week program will take place from **March 25 –April 25, 2011** in the U.S. Participants must be high school students who are at least 15 years of age and have at least 18 months left before graduation. Good English skills are required. The program is fully funded by the United States Government. Three teachers and eighteen students from **Bihac, Bijeljina and Orasje** will be selected to participate.
